It's that time of year where mowing and weed wacking is starting to take up the majority of Dave and my time. I want to thank Gail Young for helping us mow. This frees up time for Dave and I to complete other projects around the park.

Pool - The pool is open for use. A broadcast was sent out with information everyone needs to know when using the pool. There is a small dry erase board on the laundry room door that leads to the pool. If the pool is closed for any reason, it will be posted there first.

Shop Heater - A new heater has been installed in the shop. It is currently operated by a standard thermostat. I will be installing a 30 minute timer in the near future. The small propane tank only has about 20 hours worth of propane in it. It is too small to be kept on "keep full" with any propane company. I will try to get Jefferson Propane to check it occasionally during the winter, but if it is out of propane and the heater doesn't turn on, let an employee know and we can get it filled.

Water System - We have finally received approval from Washington Dept of Health to remove the chlorination from our water system. The chlorination system is still in place, and should we ever have a bad water test, the Dept of Health may require us to resume chlorination.

Staining Pool Fence & Painting - As soon as weather permits, I will be staining the pool fence and painting the exterior walls of the office and laundry buildings that face the pool deck. If anyone would like to volunteer their time and help with this project, it would be greatly appreciated. I will send out a broadcast letting volunteers know when I have this project scheduled.
