BOD Work Session  
June 21, 2018

Rocky Anderson, owner of ADC Waste Water Engineering, visited DBR on Wednesday June 13<sup>th</sup>.

- 1) Test holes were dug in several locations to assess soil conditions and health of our A & B fields, and options for expanding our current septic systems.
- 2) Draw down tests, to determine pump capacity, were conducted at all three septic fields.
- 3) An inspection of current systems and their construction was conducted at all three septic fields.

ADC wants to install a system that will last us a very long time. Rocky was concerned that if we make repairs to the Meadow, we would just be putting a band-aid on a worn out system.

One of the options ADC is exploring is to add a new septic field, which consists of an underground drip system. It is my understanding that ADC may recommend retiring the Meadow, and adding this new system, which he said could last indefinitely.

ADC is currently working to put together a proposal, to present to us and to WA. DOH.

Linda Enger was able to meet our Engineer, Dotti Ramey when she visited a couple of months ago, and several BOD members were able to meet Rocky Anderson last week. I think all are in agreement that we are in very capable hands.
