

Pet Forms: Acting on the suggestion made by Marion Head, the Team has created a form to allow DBR pet owners to document who will care for their pets in both short and long-term emergencies, with special instructions if necessary. The form will be offered after the August 8th meeting.

Emergency communications within the park: Various means of communicating critical information to park residents have been considered – a phone VM and text service, a megaphone, and just coming out of our houses to talk with each other and share information. No decisions yet on what to recommend to the park.

Medical packs update: Our park emergency AED stations will soon have a small medical pack, which will contain a tourniquet, STOP THE BLEED supplies and special scissors for cutting away clothing. Those purchases are still being arranged.

Wood stove update: The Team purchased a small wood burning stove to be used after a catastrophic event such as a major quake. It has been “cured” by having a wood fire in it for 4 hours to drive off chemicals we’d rather not breathe. It is disassembled and stored in the CERT shed.

Funds: Our current balance is about \$511.

Other items that we need to make the stove safe to use – cement Hardiebacker board, a fireproof rug, and a metal pan to catch burning bits - along with two 5” elbows to get the chimney through the exterior wall. These items are not yet approved by the Team.
