Pet Committee Report to the Board of Directors 6/28/2019

The Pet Committee met June 11, 2019 and discussed two issues: The Pet Parade and poop.

The Pet Parade is tentatively scheduled for August 4, the Sunday morning of the Leaseholders weekend. There may be dog races after the parade, if we can pull it off! We also want to incorporate trike/bike/motorcycle riders and perhaps a platoon of golf carts. We would like each street to have a theme and coordinate costumes, but if that doesn't appeal, we just want you to be in a parade and have fun! We hope everyone with a pet, real or imaginary, will participate, but if your cat refuses, or your dog is shy, or you don't have a pet or can't imagine having one, we hope you come watch and join the fun!

Poop Bags: We have been able to find a manufacturer whose bags and packaging are made from recycled materials. We would like to do a test of the product by establishing a second dispenser in the meadow. We would put it on the north side, where the tree-stumps are, and in such a way that it would not interfere with mowing the meadow. We think this might assist people who forgot to bring a bag and consequently don't pick up their dog's poop. We have the funds in our budget to cover the cost, which will be about \$150 for the stand, bag holder, and 800 bags (the minimum order amount). We are requesting Board approval of the purchase and placement of the new dispenser.

In our June 25th meeting we added Judy Sigler to the Committee, pending Board approval. Judy has been on the committee in previous years and added greatly to our discussion.

This discussion focused on reviewing the current rules for the committee, how those rules related to the descriptions in the CC&R's and the By-Laws and whether or not a more complete process is appropriate. We agreed that we need further discussion, which will be the topic of our next meeting, on July 9 at 3:30 in Radcliffe.
