

Safety Committee Report

The Safety Committee identifies and develops initiatives to assist with community safety. In the past the emphasis has been on disaster preparedness and that will continue to be a focus of the committee-maintaining supplies and keeping the community informed on issues related to preparedness. In July the committee held a meeting to review the DBR Safety Manual, with the emphasis on assuring new members of the community are informed of its contents.

In light of the pandemic, the Safety Committee is turning attention to keeping the community informed about Covid-19 and how to stay safe. Information about the virus and how we should respond will be sent out in blasts as news becomes available.

We checked with various pharmacies and local agencies and Rite Aide is interested in coming to the park and doing a flu shot clinic. The CDC says flu shots are particularly important this year because it helps to reduce the overall impact of respiratory illnesses and lessen the burden on the healthcare system during the Covid-19 pandemic. The vaccine usually arrives in mid-August so we will set up a date to have them come out as soon as it is here and we strongly encourage everyone to get vaccinated.
