### **Septic Update:**

RJ Services has completed clearing the area for the new drain field.

North of the upper nature trail - area had been previously logged, so after the small alders and cedars were removed, the area is pretty wide open with very few remaining trees. Some larger trees maples had to be removed because they had rot or were not safe. The south side of the upper nature trail was not previously logged and has numerous larger trees remaining.

After doing a layout of the drip lines, RJ Services has determined that it is impossible for them to lay the 3300 In ft of tubing with the number of trees remaining in the first two drain field zones. I've contacted the septic designer and engineer (Rocky & Jason) to see if there are any options to avoid removing additional trees.

Early next week, we are having the surveyor return to double check the location of the Southern drain field stakes.

RJ Services has also removed some of the berry bushes on the East side of the meadow and cleared an area for the construction driveway from Old Gardiner Rd. Gravel pits are closed, so they will not be able to get the rock necessary to complete the driveway until the gravel pits open.

The existing water line for the park has been located running under the upper Nature Trail. It needs to be moved at least 10" outside of the drain field area. An area has been cleared North of the new drain field area to reroute the new waterline.

DOH has given us approval to install the new drain field over the abandoned water line.

I am trying to sell the trees that have been cut to generate some money for the park. I would like to save 3-4 cords for park use.

Please stay away from the construction area when the crew is working.

If you have questions about the project, send them to me and I will get the answer for you.

**Lot Maintenance:**
