- We have continued to update our safety manual on the website and give paper copies to new owners and renters.
- The annual Cascadia Rising earthquake drill had good participation and interest.
- We continue to give seasonal reminders on extreme weather, fire safety, and wildfire smoke, or evacuation.
- The safety shed and caches have been updated and a new one placed on the east side.
- Our Fall flu shot clinic will continue thru Rite Aid at Radclyffe and we will continue to advise the park on the ongoing pandemic.
- We had a CPR refresher class with practice at the Ramada in June which also included use of the AED, stop the bleed, and choking. As a result we added a tourniquet to the shop emergency supplies and an eye wash.
- The summer safety meeting, open to all, showed various items in a 'go bag' one should have at the ready for you and your pet in case of evacuation or you are away from home in your vehicle when a disaster unfolds to survive.
- The ongoing focus of the Safety committee is aging safely at home and things we can and should do for a safer home. If there some things you can't do ask for help. We continue to comb through resources to find the best options for our community so be looking for info on this important topic going forward.
