

ALRC Monthly Report for DBR BOD meeting May 26, 2022

ALRC is in process of finalizing the proposed guidelines to turn over to the board for final approval. Phyllis has continued with the guideline revisions, and we appreciate her dedication and endurance. Minor changes have been made on the ALRC forms. A decision was made to have a short version for most common projects and a long form for park model/trailers to reduce paperwork. Karen is working with Sheryl on how best to set up these documents for both office use and for the website.

We made it through the winter with ongoing ALRC requests and permits. Phyllis and Mary did the main work of monitoring requests, receiving returned request, distributing permits and working with me to ensure accuracy of the ALRC spreadsheet.

Currently we have 13 ALRC requests. Projects include the following: (2) landscaping projects; (2) heating & cooling; (1) park model; (1) storage bin; (1) propane; (1) gravel; (3) construction projects; (1) deck; and (1) French drain. Refer to the spreadsheet on the website.

Jolda and Karen were able to complete final reviews and close out 6 ALRC requests on the projects where permits had been returned.

We are aware there may be several projects that may have been completed, and we are in the process of identifying those whose permits have not yet been returned. Those projects are also monitored on the spreadsheet.

The ALRC committee will continue to work on the proposed guideline changes until it is completed. We will also work with the office and webmaster to ensure final postings and distribution of forms.
