Nature Trail Survey Update

- It appears as though the survey complete on the parcel at the East end of our lower Nature Trail is incorrect and survey stakes have been placed on our property
- We have placed caution tape and No Trespassing signs along our boarder of the Nature Trail
- A couple of the markers from our original survey have been found and spray painted red
- Sections of the original barbed wire fence, shown on the original survey to be our property line, have been found and painted
- Next week, we will continue to look for additional survey pins and barbed wire fence and get those marked
- Two survey companies have been asked to give us an estimate on completing the survey of Eastland

Update & Additional Info

- I was able to locate and speak with the surveyor. He relayed the following:
 - The property was sold to a couple who bought it for pleasure.
 - They may build on the water side (Old Gardiner Rd) in about 3 years
 - He said they had no plans to log it

- The surveyor notified the owners of the presence of our Nature Trail. They weren't concerned and seemed willing to grant an easement if the Nature Trail is on their property

Next Steps

- Locate more of our original survey pins and boundary fence
- Meet with the surveyor to compare surveys and correct the boundaries
