Re: Proposed Park Rules Expansion: Allows Growing of Medical Cannabis on individual LH sites.

The women who grow medical cannabis at DBWC shall do so while adhering to Washington State Law. That means

- Each Grower will be knowledgeable of Washington State Law as it regulates the growing of medical cannabis.
- Each Grower will become familiar with applicable County laws and procedures.
- Medical marijuana will be grown only by women who have current medical marijuana licenses.

A copy of the Grower's current medical license will be posted with the plants.

- Growers will plant, tend, and process medical cannabis only on their own site.
- Growers will plant no more than the number of plants allowed by their medical license.
- Plants will be grown, harvested, and processed out of sight of public view from Highway 101 and Old Gardiner Road.
- Temporary screens, trellises, or shade cloths may be used to assist and to conceal plants at various stages of their growth with LARC approval.
- Plant aroma is highest at time of harvesting and while drying; growers will take every practical step to confine odor with plant protection enclosures and notify neighbors of processing times so they can avoid the area or close their windows.
- Growers will apply to LARC for permits if they choose to install a greenhouse.
