Clarification just because: There is no Cannabis Club. We are a group of friends who smoke or otherwise use cannabis – and some of us do not. We share information also, but the discussions about growing and smoking have made us function as more of an organized group than we otherwise would be. Just for your information.

Request for Accommodation of Smoking Cannabis within DBR

Our group respects the health concerns of our neighbors. We acknowledge that, even with well intentioned precautions, passers-by may be able to smell residual smoke when we gather on each others decks. As dog owners avoid certain streets because their dog gets into fierce barking matches with the resident dogs, women who are profoundly opposed to any evidence of cannabis smoke are able to easily avoid a large gathering of cannabis smokers. At DBR, we accommodate each other in different ways since we live in such close proximity. Our parties only involve a few minutes of actual smoking, so we believe this is a reasonable accomodation to request. That being said, these proposed agreements will enable us to smoke in designated areas **FURTHER AWAY** from our individual lots. This will reduce the number of large smoking gatherings at our individual homes; although personal parties will still occur.

We propose that smoking be allowed:

1. Outside on private lots, decks, and lawns and at least 25 feet from any common building.
2. At the Ramada when no other resident is present,
3. At the picnic tables below Radclyffe,
4. At the lower fire pit,
5. In the meadow when no other resident is present and not within 25 feet of any residence.
