About Our Community

Discovery Bay Resort (DBR) was established in 1996 as an RV park. In 2023 it was reorganized and Discovery Bay Women's Club (DBWC) was founded. DBWC governs, operates, and maintains Discovery Bay Resort.

Women aged 21 and older are welcomed as full-time or seasonal residents. Currently most residents are retired. We have approximately 130 members who live on the 115 Sites in the Park.

DBR was originally designed for seasonal RV'ers and is situated on a series of terraces yielding views of Discovery Bay, a grassy meadow, the mountains and the forest. Our "Winter Warriors" sometimes experience these vistas covered with snow.

The Park is governed by an elected volunteer Board of Directors and is served by a Park Facilities Staff. There are many opportunities for service and involvement in the community.

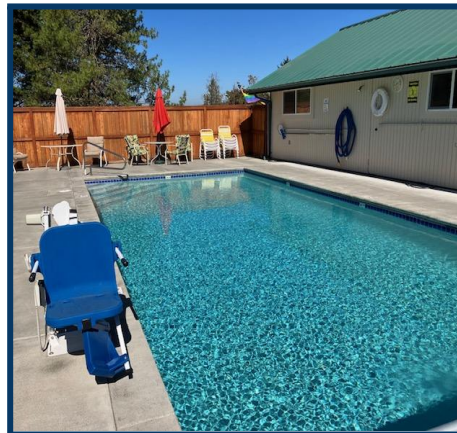
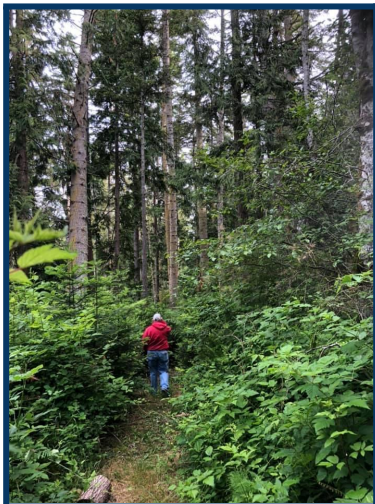


Park Amenities and Facilities

Discovery Bay Resort Offers 24-hour use of amenities and facilities including :

- Office and Lounge with WiFi, computer, printer, pool table, Foos Ball table and TV
- Radclyffe Hall Meeting and Living Room with full kitchen, library, WiFi, TV, piano
- The Ramada (outside meeting and picnic area) with seating, picnic tables, BBQ's, TV
- Seasonal Heated Outdoor Swimming Pool
- Fitness/Exercise Room
- Low Cost Coin-Operated Laundry Room
- Pet Areas and Pet Stations - fenced dog run and an off leash meadow
- Nature Trail - a .5 mile walk through a beautiful evergreen forest on our property

Members have opportunities to create their own or participate in community sponsored activities.
