#### **Suggestion, Idea:**

Storage Bin for Water Barrels or Emergency Food Supplies (max 72 cu. Ft)

- We are requesting that the BOD allow an additional storage bin per site, in which residents can store their water barrels to keep their emergency water and supplies, such as water pumps, clean and dry. Or to allow residents to store emergency supplies. Bins are to remain within all lot lines.
- Current LARC standards allow 2 storage bins (72 cu. Ft max) plus a generator bin.
- From the Washington State Emergency Preparedness website: You may need to survive on your own after a disaster. This means having your own water, and other supplies in sufficient quantity to last for a minimum of 2 weeks, but allow for the possibility of several months.
- Most of our homes do not allow us enough storage area in which to store the emergency supplies that we will need when disaster strikes.

**Expectations of Use: effective use for residents to maintain safe and clean environments for their emergency needs.**
