

Green Team BOD Report 5-28-26

The Green Team has met twice since last report. Our discussions have covered:

1. A concern about lights in the park during the night that both disturb people and disorient birds. Further information needed but meanwhile lights on the common buildings could be the motion autoactivated.
2. We remain concerned about invasive species starting with the holly.
3. Research suggested that planting clover on the berms would be possible to reduce the need for mowing saving considerable expense for the park. The idea was dropped because some people might be allergic to bees.
4. The trail guide is being re-activated with new markers and information.
5. We will be having a bus ride activity and are encouraging ride sharing.
6. We will be sending out weekly sustainable hints beginning with a series called SOS (Save Our Septic) that focuses on saving water and reducing what goes into our current system that we need to treat gently until we are able to replace it.
