Request for Action

I propose adding to our Rules an additional definition to cover **Non-Residential Social Members**

Under our Bylaws DBWC has two classes of membership: RV members (defined as leaseholders) and Social Members (defined as non-leaseholders). Social Members consist only of women who "sublease a site from an RV Member or occupies a site for more than 30 days (DBWC Guidelines and Rules 8/1/2023, 4.2")

Unfortunately this definition fails to account for any women who formerly resided at DBR or those who maintain an interest in our community and occasionally attend events. These women are simply a "guest" with its limitations.

I encourage creation of a Non-Residential Social Membership to accommodate and welcome those who have a demonstrated interest in our community.

Qualifications for this membership are principally the same as for Social Members. Non-resident Social Members similarly would need to be:

- sponsored for membership by one or more RV members
- be approved by the Board of Directors
- pay a required annual fee of \$25 (or more-this is the current Social Member fee)
- sign a liability waiver upon acceptance

Upon acceptance of membership as a Non-Resident Social Member these women would be **limited to the following privileges only:**

- Limited web access to view the DBWC Activities Calendar only
- Access to the park to attend activities such as concerts and on-going potlucks or general meetings
- Access to walk in the park subject to rules for hours, noise, parking

Non-resident Social Members will have :

- no access to committee meetings or Annual Meeting
- They may not use the pool unless accompanied by an RV member
- no access to use of laundry room
- No booking of DBR facilities for any individual event. (They may book if sponsored by an RV Member)
