Information that you should consider as you plan to put a dwelling on your Site	
- Your unit cannot be more than two feet off of the ground when it is placed on the Site. - Your unit must meet or exceed ANCI Standards - Skirting must be installed on a park model no later than 90 days after it is put on your Site - Propane requires a county permit - If you plan on placing a shed or accessory room on your site, in the future it may affect the placement of your living unit.	

It is critical that you refer to the LARC Standards for rules for placement of structures on Sites. Use the LARC Design Form to request a permit for skirting, steps, ramps, decks, railings, greenhouses, etc.
