

DBR Green Team's Suggestions for Ways to Re-home Unwanted Items

GIVING AWAY

Clothing and linens/giving away - There are two large cardboard boxes under the counter in the laundry room – place in one of the boxes. A DBR volunteer occasionally takes the items to town to the Serenity House or other non-profit. Until then, the items are available to anyone in the park, so check there periodically and you might find a free pair of jeans, or a great sweater or even a jacket!

Small items/giving away – take up to the office and place on the counter to the right of the kitchen sink. Make a note to yourself that after one week you will retrieve it and find a different way to rehome your item. Please don't forget because otherwise someone else (the staff) will have to deal with your stuff. Consider taking it to one of the thrift stores or Around Again (see below) if it's still there after a week.

Larger items that won't fit on the office kitchen counter/giving away - post on ChitChat or write a short message on the white board in the office – display at home on your porch, your deck, in your shed. If no one takes it within a week, consider other options. Consider taking it to one of the thrift stores or Around Again (see below).

Tools/hardware – Consider donating it to the DBR workshop, but please do so by contacting either Lynne Angeloro or Tenna Matthews - volunteers who keep an eye on the workshop contents and organization.

Giving away wood – take it up to the DBR workshop and leave it outside on the left side of the workshop. Alternatively, you could take it to Around Again (see below).

Donating to Habitat for Humanity – new & used furniture, appliances, and building supplies: Port Angeles & Sequim – all donations must be made at the PA store – none are taken at the Sequim store. Port Townsend will accept donations.

Donating items to a church for resale as a fundraiser – If you see information about a church's fundraiser "garage" or "rummage" sale, please notify the Green Team and provide a flyer or basic info: date and time they will accept donations, and what sort of items they will and will NOT accept. The GT will blast the info out to the park as soon as possible.

AROUND AGAIN – is a non-profit located out Hwy 101, West of Sequim. They are at the first intersection on your right after you pass over the Dungeness River. They take donated items which they then sell for very nominal prices – just enough to stay open. Their goal is to help people reuse items or "use up" things like paint and tile and half packages of various things. They take furniture, artwork, construction materials including doors and windows, screws, nails, caulk, tools, toys, sports equipment – a LOT of things. They take things that NO ONE ELSE will take – for example plastic pots, gardening supplies. Check them out sometime just in case you need ONE or TWO of something some day and don't want to buy a whole pack. Another place a lot like it is Waste Not Want Not in Port Townsend.
